Major transitions

- ☐ Miami urban start to Tamiami Trail
- ☐ Big Cypress crossing to Naples
- ☐ Gulf Coast towns to Tampa Bay
- ☐ Tampa Bay to inland springs country
- ☐ Lake City and Jasper to the Georgia border

Decide the shape before adding stops

- ☐ Choose whether the Tamiami crossing is a through-drive or a stop-rich nature section.
- ☐ Use Naples, Fort Myers, Sarasota, Tampa, or Lake City as major resets rather than treating every Gulf Coast town as equal.
- ☐ Separate US 41 mainline travel from downtown, beach, barrier-island, and waterfront detours.
- ☐ Check current weather, flooding, construction, park access, and seasonal facility conditions close to travel.

Reset / overnight posture: Many choices; prioritize Naples, Fort Myers, Sarasota, Tampa, and Lake City according to trip phase.
