Role in the whole route: Agricultural corridor, Middle Georgia city sequence, Atlanta metropolitan hinge, and north-Georgia handoff.

Major transitions

- ☐ Florida border to Valdosta
- ☐ South Georgia agriculture to Tifton and Cordele
- ☐ Perry and Warner Robins to Macon
- ☐ Forsyth and Griffin to metro Atlanta
- ☐ Marietta and Kennesaw to Cartersville and Dalton

Decide the shape before adding stops

- ☐ Use Valdosta, Macon, Atlanta, and Dalton as the main planning anchors.
- ☐ Keep US 41 distinct from parallel I-75 and from destination streets reached after leaving the corridor.
- ☐ Treat smaller towns as pacing, orientation, and service support unless the traveler has a specific destination.

Reset / overnight posture: Valdosta, Macon, and Atlanta are the strongest overnight choices; Dalton is a useful northern reset.
