Paper is for decisions, notes, and offline reference. Re-check weather, construction, closures, hours, bridge operations, lodging, parking, fuel, and seasonal access close to travel.

Kentucky at a glance

Role in the whole route: Compact western-Kentucky chapter and Ohio River approach.

Primary anchors

Hopkinsville

Henderson

Major transitions

- ☐ Tennessee border to Hopkinsville
- ☐ Hopkinsville to Madisonville
- ☐ Henderson and the Ohio River crossing

Decide the shape before adding stops

- ☐ Use Hopkinsville as the southern anchor and Henderson as the river-crossing hinge.
- ☐ Treat Madisonville and smaller corridor communities as pacing and service support.
- ☐ Resolve Earlington, Mortons Gap, and Robards structurally before presenting them as ordered-spine stops.

Reset / overnight posture: Hopkinsville and Henderson are the strongest overnight/reset choices.

Utility posture: No named utility is approved for projection; rely on general corridor-service guidance.
