Enter with this decision: At Monteagle, understand the mainline-versus-US 41A decision before following destination pages or signs.

Drive rhythm

Mountain and plateau transition, smaller-city sequence, major Nashville hinge, then a quieter border approach.

Logical stop sequence

1 Chattanooga on

2 Monteagle on

3 Murfreesboro

4 Nashville on

5 Springfield

Exit decision: Leave Springfield on the current mainline toward Hopkinsville rather than routing through Clarksville.
