Tennessee Route 41 State Planner

US 41 crosses Chattanooga, climbs toward Monteagle, then follows the current mainline through Manchester, Murfreesboro, Nashville, and Springfield while US 41A remains a separate branch system.

Tennessee at a glance

Role in the whole route: Tennessee River gateway, mountain and plateau transition, capital-city hinge, and the route's most important branch-identity chapter.

Decide the shape before adding stops

- ☐ Decide deliberately between current US 41 and US 41A branch destinations.
- ☐ Use Chattanooga and Nashville as the primary anchors, with Monteagle as the mountain-orientation hinge.
- ☐ Keep branch towns useful without routing the mainline through them.

Reset / overnight posture: Chattanooga and Nashville are primary overnight anchors; Murfreesboro and Monteagle can support narrower plans.

Keep route claims honest

- ☐ Clarksville, Sewanee, Shelbyville, Tullahoma, and Winchester must not be presented as current-US 41 mainline sequence.
- ☐ Fayetteville is not verified on current US 41 or US 41A and requires structural review.

Utility posture: No named utility is approved for Route41 site projection; use general mountain, fuel, and rest planning.
