Role in the whole route: Lake Michigan entry, freeway-based metropolitan corridor, Lake Winnebago and Fox Valley sequence, and Michigan-border approach.

Major transitions

- ☐ Illinois border to Kenosha and Racine

Decide the shape before adding stops

- ☐ Separate I-41 through-driving from lakefront downtowns and riverfront destinations.
- ☐ Use Milwaukee, the Lake Winnebago anchors, Appleton, Green Bay, and Marinette for major resets.
- ☐ Treat support pages such as Oak Creek, Lomira, Neenah, Little Chute, and De Pere as corridor support without fabricated route order.

Reset / overnight posture: Milwaukee and Green Bay are strongest; Oshkosh and Appleton provide useful middle-state alternatives.

- ☐ Construction, lane configuration, and interchange access are dynamic and belong to WisDOT traveler resources.

Utility posture: No named Route41 utility is approved for site projection; use general freeway-service guidance.
